WHAT TO EXPECT

Each Sunday we have engaging activities throughout service. We start off with welcome time where kids hang out, we move into worship and lesson time, followed by small groups discussing the lesson and doing activities to help build relationships with their leaders and friends.

WHO IS WORKING WITH YOUR CHILD

All of our volunteers have been background checked, completed ministry safe, and have gone through our Anthem KIDS volunteer training prior to serving in our ministry.

CHECK IN

When arriving to Anthem KIDS you will be greeted by our volunteers at check in. They will get your info in our system and labels for you and your kids. Then you will be led to your child's class, where you will meet their teachers.

What safety precautions do you have for my kids?

At Anthem volunteers from the Security Team and Anthem KIDS Team will be stationed in the kid's area. No one will be allowed to enter the kids wing without a pick-up tag. Additionally, no child will be dismissed from class without a parent. There are also 2 volunteers per room. We have half doors and windows so all rooms are visible from the hallway and other classrooms.

Are restroom facilities available for my family?

Yes. Each classroom has a bathroom accessible as well as 2 bathrooms in the hall, and one family bathroom outside the KIDS space.

Will I be able to check in on my kids?

Yes. If you have your pick-up tag you will be allowed in the KIDS space. You can peek in your child's room through the door or ask the check in volunteers how they are doing.

How will I check my kids out?

You will show your pickup tag to enter the KIDS space. From there you will give your tag to the teacher and pick up your child.

Will my kids be photographed?

It is very possible your child could be videoed or photographed. We post on Facebook and our website. On your first visit when you fill out the information sheet there is a disclaimer about this. If you do not want your child photographed please state that on the form.

Will the kids have a snack time?

No. We do not give out snacks during their time in Anthem KIDS.

If my child has allergies how do the volunteers know?

In our initial check in process we ask if your child has any allergies. If stated they will print on your child's name tag every time you visit, so the volunteers know what the allergies are. If a new allergy develops inform one of the check in volunteers to update your child's allergy information.

What if my child needs me during service?

A text message will be sent to your phone if your child needs you during service.

What should I bring with my child to Anthem KIDS?

Younger children not fully potty trained please bring extra clothes, diapers/pullups, wipes. Please label all items and any diaper bags with child's name.
